Papa Johns Pizza Shop Planning Application – RS

- It was a unanimous decision to refuse the application based on child obesity and the NDP
- Papa Johns Pizza could yet appeal this decision

5G Mast on Lawrence Weston Rd Pre Planning Application – RS
